1	“Amend statutory code on performance audits to include the effectiveness and results of the bond program.”	<p>Amend Education Code Section 14502.1 to require. (2)</p> <p>Note: CABOC proposal follows the same process as Senate Bill No. 584, Chapter 167, August 27, 2013 which established the requirement for the current annual compliance performance audit. These current standards are published by the Educational Audit Appeals Panel in <i>Guide for Annual Audits</i> as Appendix A.</p>
2	“Expand the role of Citizens’ Bond Oversight Committee in selecting and interacting with bond program auditors”	<p>Amend Education Code Section 15278(b) to provide that the CBOC will engage with the district in determining scope and selection of performance auditor. (3)</p> <p>Amend Education Code Section 15278(c) authorizing the CBOC to establish its own bylaws. (8)</p> <p>Amend Education Code Section 15278 CBOC shall conduct an entrance and exit conference with each auditor and shall receive draft audit reports at the same time as they are delivered to the district. (9)</p>
3	”Require bond measures proposed to voters under the reduced threshold to include specific project lists.”	Amend Education Code Section 15278 to provide that the district’s facilities master plan shall include a description of all projects and their funding sources. (4)

4	“Change the appointment authority for members of Citizens’ Bond Oversight Committees.”	Provides for a transparent and open process for the selection and appointment by the Board of Education of CBOC members. (5)
5	“Require districts to provide a minimal budget for the oversight committees, including a budget to hire independent counsel with municipal bond expertise.”	Amends Education Code Section 15280(a) (1) authorized the appointment of a CBOC independent legal counsel paid from bond funds. (6)
6	“Require districts to provide a Web presence for Citizens’ Bond Oversight Committees to prominently display meeting agendas and reports.”	Amends Education Code Section 15280(b) to provide for CBOC to control the CBOC website. (7)
